Breakfast is my favourite meal of the day in Fiji; there is something so special sitting listening to the birds in the morning with a fresh cup of coffee and a bowl of fresh tropical fruit. For this reason, I always recommend guests book breakfast during their stay.

Mere will prepare young coconuts or fresh fruit juice, tropical fruit platter, cereal and yoghurt, hot cooked breakfast (eggs, pancakes, etc.) and house-made muffins or local pastries. We have a professional coffee machine with locally roasted organic coffee. Mere scrambled eggs and pancakes are famous amongst our returning guests.

Breakfast - \$60FJD per adult and FJD\$30 per child (11 years and under).

LOCAL SHOPPING

Supermarkets, local roadside stalls and Navua Market

Located just a 5-minute drive from Villa Tinikatolu is the central hub of Pacific Harbour. The village offers a range of very casual dining options from lunchtime wraps and smoothies to pizza, restaurants, and bars.

Further down the road are local fresh fruit and vegetable stalls. Grace Rd Supermarket has an international range of products as well as their own vegetables grown on their farms. They also have a food court serving up fresh meals including sushi which can also be taken away.

Navua township has a small but lively fresh food market and more well stocked supermarkets.

SELF-CATERING & SHOPPING SERVICE

Pacific Harbor village and Navua township are close by and offer supermarkets, restaurants and casual food options. Fresh fruit and vegetable can also be found at roadside stalls or Navua Market.

Our Property Manager, Nukai, can take you on local shopping trips using the villa vehicle (Toyota Hilux).

A helpful shopping list is provided below.

Breakfast:

- Fresh Fruit – what Mere can find available in the market
- Fruit juices
- Milk - all milk is long-life and other types like almond are available
- Yoghurt – plain or flavoured?
- Cereal – Corn flakes, Rice Bubbles or muesli/granola
- Frozen berries or mango for smoothies
- Butter or margarine
- Bread for toast
- Eggs – for scrambled, fried or poached
- Bacon – must be ordered in advance from a supplier
- Tomatoes – if in season do you like fried tomatoes with a cooked breakfast
- Cheese – some people like cheese eggs

- Hash browns – Mere can buy boxed of frozen ones
- Breakfast sausages
- Tomato Sauce
- Condiments for toast – honey, jam or marmalade

Lunches or dinners:

- Salad item - lettuce, tomatoes and cucumber
- Vegetables – onions, garlic, potatoes, cabbage, Asian green, beans etc
- Meat
- Fish
- Avocadoes - are not usually available in winter but if they are they are about \$1fjd0 each
- Mayonnaise – only basic like Praise available
- Sliced Ham
- Roast chickens can be purchased from the local supermarket
- Tinned tuna or salmon
- Cheese – this is not a common item in Fiji small packet of Mainland are available at about \$20fjd each
